## Overview

---

This report contains the 2022-2030 EV charging strategy that has been developed for the Dublin LAs. Action 79 of the Climate Action Plan commits to developing a roadmap on the optimum mix of regulatory, taxation and subsidy policies to drive significant ramp-up in passenger EVs and electric van sales from very early in the next decade. 1 million EVs planned to be on the road by 2030. But the numbers conceal a more complex narrative: one shaped by shifting global headwinds, an evolving consumer profile, and intensifying international competition. [1] As of 2022, about 13% of new cars registered in the country were fully electric, and 7% were plug-in hybrid. [3] In 2022. 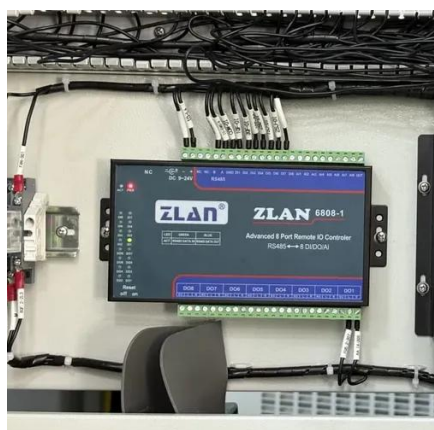
