


Overview

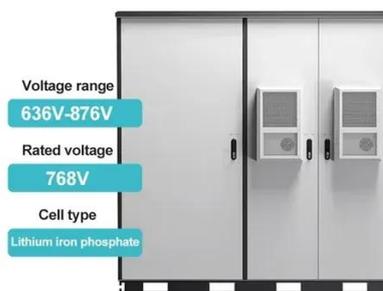

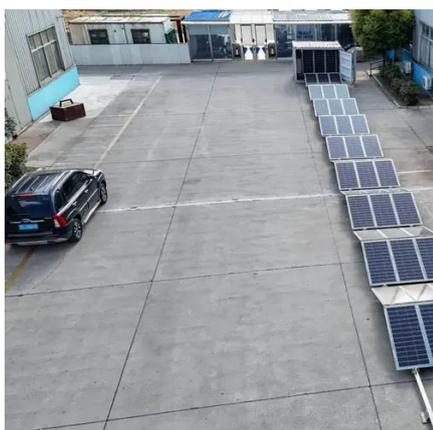
