



Solar power croatia



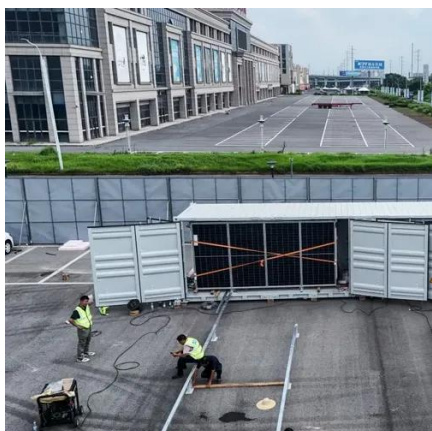


Overview

Croatia installed a total 397 MW of solar in 2024, bringing its cumulative capacity to around 872 MW, and surpassed the 1 GW milestone in May. If the trend seen in the first half continues throughout 2025, it is expected that Croatia's solar capacity will reach 1,290 MW by the end. Croatia's solar market continues to grow steadily, led by the self-supply and commercial and industrial (C&I) segments, while regulatory barriers stall utility-scale development. The expansion is part of the country's broader commitment to renewable energy and aligns with EU targets to boost the share of renewables in electricity generation. At the end of November 2024, Croatia had 25,406 solar power plants on the distribution grid, with a total capacity of 776 MW. This includes 980 MW connected to the distribution grid and 119 MW to the transmission grid, accounting for 5.

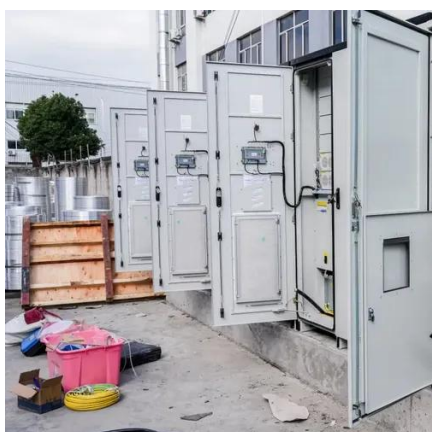
