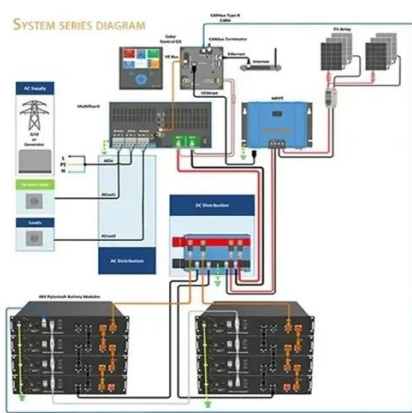

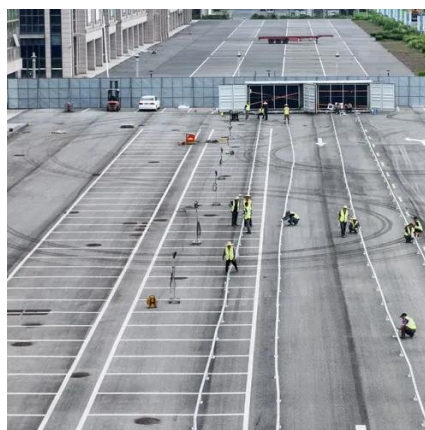


Do Lithium Batteries Need Full Charge First Time?
